

Eligibility:

Graduating senior from a high school in Genesee County

Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5/4.0 scale

Amount of scholarship: \$500 / Applicant

Selection Process:

Application materials, including essays, will be reviewed by the Board of Directors. Notification of the scholarship award will be made by May 1, 2021.

Awarding of scholarship:

The scholarship certificate will be presented at the 202 Salute to Black Scholars Celebration. The recipient is expected to be in attendance to receive the award.

Upon proof of enrollment in college via **an official class schedule**, scholarship funds will be made payable to the student.1

Application must include:

Completion of scholarship application form

Official high school transcript and a copy of ACT or SAT scores results

Three letters for recommendation from individuals not related to the student.

Two letters should be from the principal, teacher, counselor or other high school staff who can speak to the academic capabilities of the student. The other letter should come from the students' church or someone within the community who can speak to the applicant's service within Genesee County.
